The Commercial and Industrial Department works in partnership with the TVA to provide the Comprehensive Services Program (CSP) at no charge to businesses in our service area. A detailed report is provided about ways to reduce energy consumption and operate more efficiently. There are currently eight services available in the CSP: Energy Management Surveys, Infrared Scanning, Power Quality Analysis, Special Metering, Compressed Air Leak Survey, HVAC Recommendations, Lighting Design Recommendations, and Wiring Recommendations.
