Call before you dig.

THINK YOU SMELL GAS?

If the odor is **STRONG**:

- ▶ Leave the area **IMMEDIATELY**
- ▶ Call 911 from a neighbor's or a safe distance
- ▶ Do not use electricity (including lights), matches or lighters near the smell
- ▶ **DO NOT** try to locate the leak yourself

If the odor is **WEAK**:

- ▶ Open doors and windows
- ▶ Leave the house
- ▶ Use a neighbor's phone to call the Natural Gas Department & report the leak (256-53-LIGHT/ 256-535-4448).
